SECOND: The name of the corporation (which is hereinafter called "the corporation") is:

THIRD: The purpose for which the corporation is formed and the business or objects to be carried on and promoted by it are as follows:

To promote the general welfare and professional interest of the educators of Montgomery County, Maryland;

To improve the teaching facilities of the County and to raise educational standards;

To cooperate, whenever expedient, with the State and National education organizations and with other organizations interested in advancing the cause of education;

To aid in obtaining legislation favorable to youth, to educators, and to the school system; and

To serve as the official representative voice of the educators of Montgomery County, Maryland;

To purchase, lease, and otherwise acquire, hold, mortgage, convey, and otherwise dispess of all kinds of property, both real and personal, both in this State and all other states, territories and dependencies of the United States, and generally to perform all acts which may be deceed necessary or expedient for the proper and successful prosecution of the objects and purposes

for which the corporation is created.

HITHEOS:

FOURTH: The post office address of the place at which the principal office of the corporation in this State will be located in Richard Montgomery High School, Rockville, Maryland. The resident agent of the corporation is Joseph J. Tarallo, whose post office address is Richard Montgomery High School, Bookville, Haryland. Said resident agent is a citizen of the State of Maryland and actually resides therein.

FIFTH: No dividence chall be paid by this corporation, and there shall be no division of property to any member.

SILTH: The corporation shall have no capital stock.

EXAMPLE: The corporation shall have a Scard of Directors, otherwise known as the Executive Committee, of not less than three (3) members, and such number in excess of three (3) as from time to time may be prescribed by the by-laws of the corporation. Joseph J. Tarallo, Harian L. Curling and Abel A. Horris, Jr. shall act as such until the first meeting of the Representative Assembly of the Corporation or until their successors are duly elected and qualified. They shall also be members of the Corporation.

EIGHTH: Membership in the Corporation shall be classified as Active and Associate, but this Corporation may by its by-laws authorize methods and condiditions upon which its membership shall vote, may be enlarged and further classified; any prescribe for each class of membership the dues to be paid by members of each class; may prescribe the rights and privileges of its members; and may prescribe the conditions under which members may resign, be expelled, or suspended from membership.

MONTGOMERY COUNTY EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, INC. ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

Montgomery County Education Association, Inc., a Maryland corporation, having its principal office in Montgomery County, Maryland, (hereinafter called the Corporation), hereby certifies to the State Department of Assessments and Taxations that:

FIRST: The Charter of the Corporation is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph of Article THIRD of the Articles of Incorporation and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To organize and operate an association exclusively for educational, charitable, scientific or welfare purposes, no part of the net earnings of which is to inure to the benefit of any member or other individual.

For the general purposes aforesaid, and limited to those purposes, the corporation shall have the following powers and purposes:"

AND said Charter of the Corporation is hereby further amended by striking out Article FIFTH of the Articles of Incorporation and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

*The corporation is not organized and shall not be conducted for a profit. In the event of the dissolution of this corporation, all of its remaining assets and property of every nature and description whatsoever shall be paid over and transferred to a corporation, fund, or foundation having similar objects and purposes as this corporation and which has qualified for exemption

from tax under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended; or which is an exclusively charitable or educational corporation which has qualified for exemption from tax under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended."

SECOND: That the Board of Directors of the Corporation, known as the Executive Committee, at a meeting duly convened and held on May 16, 1963 adopted a resolution in which was set forth the foregoing amendment to the charter declaring that the said amendment of the charter was advisable, and directing that it be submitted for action thereon at a meeting of the Delegate Assembly of the members of the corporation to be held on September 5, 1963.

Assembly of the Corporation (such corporation being a membership corporation without capital stock), was held on the aforesaid date in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and the By-Laws of the Corporation, notice having been given to the aforesaid members stating that the purpose of the meeting would be to take action on said Amendment, and the Amendment of the Charter of the Corporation as hereinabove set forth was approved by the members of the Delegate Assembly of the Corporation at said meeting by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the votes entitled to be cast thereon.
